Singapore sure isn't an easy place to take pictures. I have only been there once (2,5 years ago) and although you are allowed to watch the air planes, taking pictures is forbidden.  Tengah is a little easier, because you are in the middle of a closed park and nobody will see you. However, the F-16's are rather high for good pictures.  
 Of course it is all on your own risk, but I would refrain from taking pictures.  
 Don't forget to visit the Air Force museum at Paya Lebar.  
 Take bus SBS94 from Eunos MRT station or bus SBS90 from Toa Payoh Bus Interchange. There's a bus stop in front of the museum.

From the museum you won't be able to see the active planes at the airport unless they are coming in while you are just outside the museum. In that case you can see them arriving through the trees, so taking photo's won't be

At Changi International you can go to the observation-corner. In this way you'll be able to read some of the Kc135's and Fokker 50's which are based here. If you're lucky they will fly during the day and when they do you'll be : Waiting for those planes and don't give anything for civil, it will be very boring because they don't fly much. Didn't have problems with photographing while at Changi International.

We didn't see military planes at Seletar so, when you're not into civil I won't go there. Don't know exactly how to go there, except for the fact that you'll first have to go to Yio Chu Kang MRT station. From here we took a bus, & It's possible to arrange a platformtour over here.
